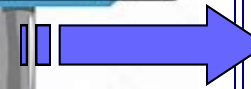

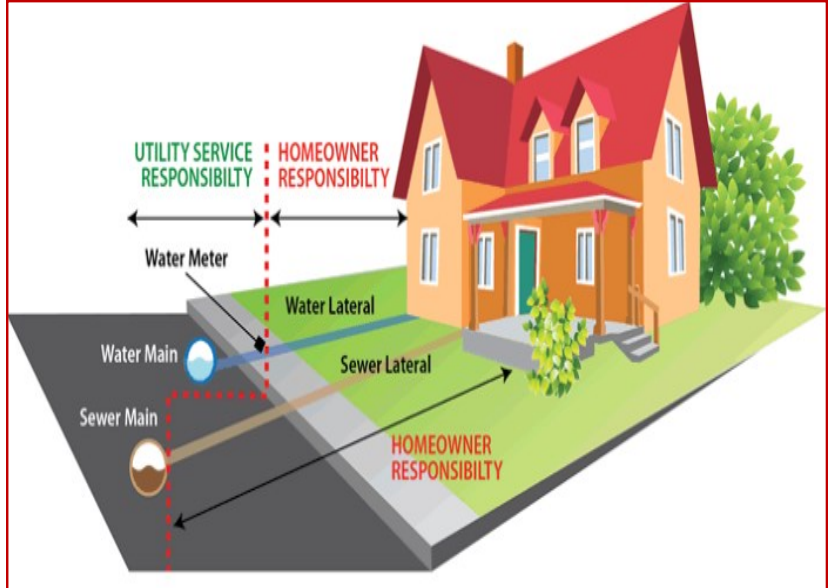

ATWATER CITY CODE FOR WATER & SEWER LINE REPAIR

The owner shall be responsible for maintaining the service pipes from the "T" or Wye at the water main into the house served. If he fails to repair any leak or other malfunction, including but not limited to Freeze-Ups, in such service pipe within 24 hours after notice by the city, the city may turn the water off. The water shall not be turned on again until the total cost of repair has been paid to the city. When the waste of water is great or damage is likely to result from the leak, or other malfunction, the city shall turn the water off immediately upon the giving of notice if repair is not commenced immediately.
